### Student Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be:

- A high school senior, attending school in Illinois.
- A U.S citizen or legal resident.
- Completing the final semester of high school and anticipating a high school diploma at the time of application.
- Planning to pursue a degree at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution at time of application.
- Accepted to an accredited U.S. post-secondary educational institution at time scholarship is awarded.

### Entry Requirements

- Entries must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent font with one-inch margins.
- Entries will be written based on the topic provided and will be approximately 500 words (but will not exceed 1000 words).
- Essays are to be submitted as a pdf file along with the registration form as a separate pdf file.
- Do not place your name or your school's name on any of the pages of the essay.
- Essays will be disqualified if it does not meet the requirements or is postmarked after the submission date (05/25/20).
- Essays will become the property of Paul Revere Lodge No. 998 once it is submitted and will not be returned.
